Internally	Actions
Waste management	 We will keep materials digitally and will only print things if absolutely necessary. We will reduce the amount of waste produced and recycle where possible. We will prevent the release of pollutants that can cause environmental damage.
Office supplies	We will consider the environmental impact of any new products we intend to purchase.
Maintenance and office cleaning	We work remotely and so do not have a dedicated office, but if we ever did, the cleaning materials we would use will be checked to ensure they're as environmentally friendly as possible.
Monitoring and improvement	 We will continually monitor our actions with the aim of improving environmental performance.
Energy	 Lights and electrical equipment will be switched off when not in use and our heating will be adjusted with energy consumption in mind.
Our people	 We will increase employee awareness through training.

Water	 We will avoid water wastage wherever possible.
Chemicals and hazardous substances	 We do not use chemicals or hazardous substances to carry out our business activities, but if we ever did, then wherever possible we will substitute substances that are harmful to the environment with those that have less of an impact.
Legal duties	 We will keep up to change with changes in environmental law and ensure we are fully compliant with our duties.

Transportation	 We'll reduce the need to travel, wherever possible. We'll promote the use of alternatives to travel, such as email or video/phone conferences.
Customers, contractors, suppliers and other stakeholders	Wherever possible, we will work with third parties who are equally as committed to improve their environmental performance.
